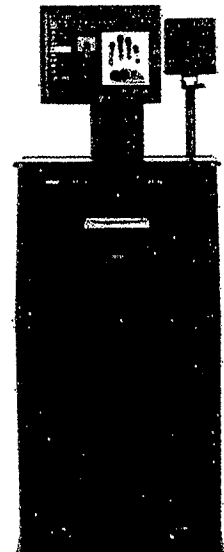

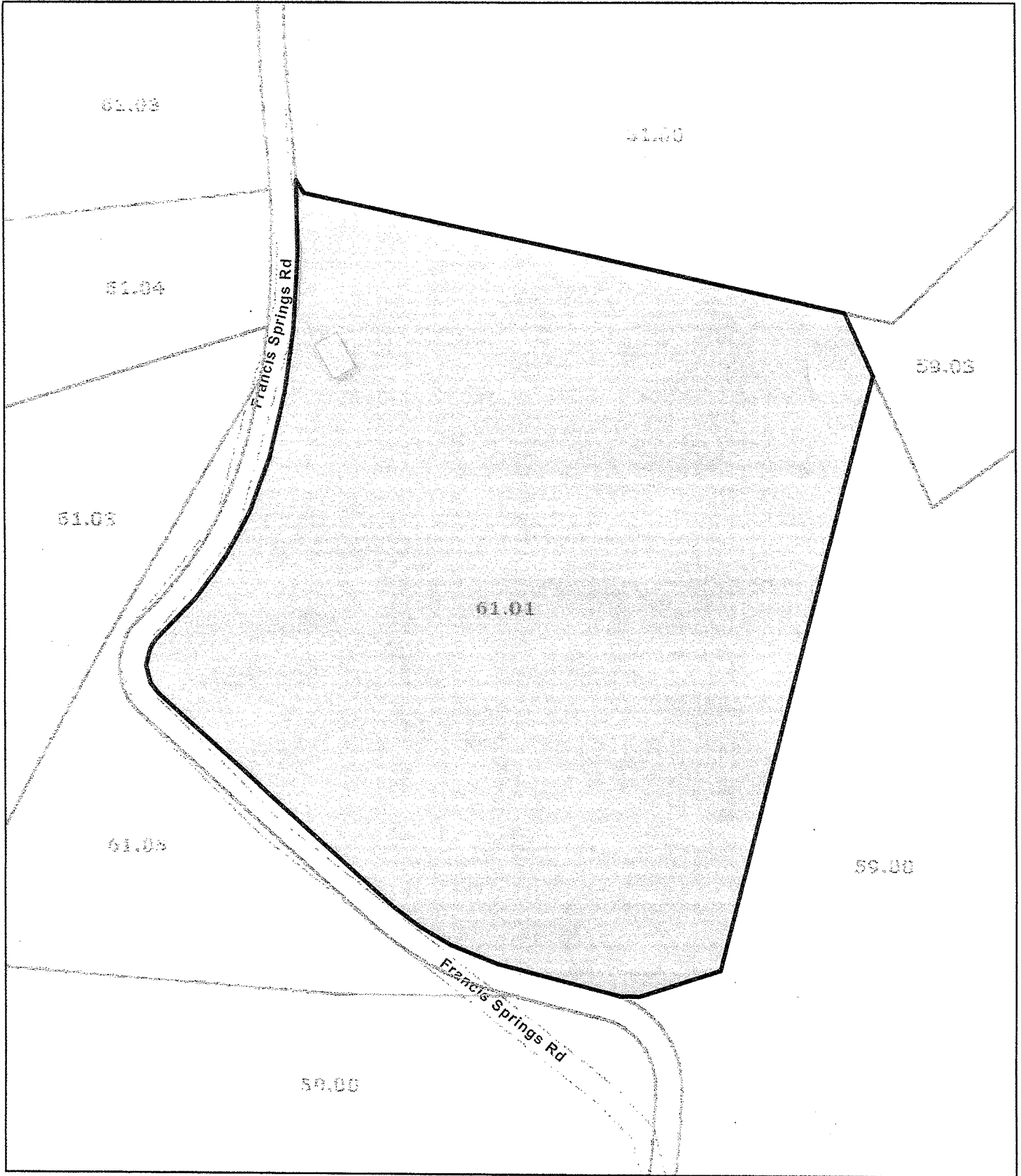

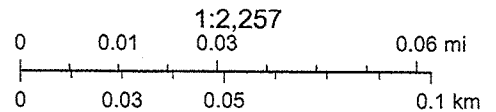

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF MARION COUNTY, TENNESSEE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE (IECC), 2018 EDITION, AS PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CODE CONGRESS (ICC), WITH EXCEPTIONS, BY REFERENCE AS PROVIDED BY TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED SECTIONS 5-20-101, *ET SEQ.*

WHEREAS, by previous Resolutions, the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Tennessee, adopted the 2018 editions of the International Building Code, its appendices and supplements and all subsequent editions, as promulgated by the International Code Council (“ICC”), with the exception of the International Energy Conservation Code (“IECC”), by reference as the official building code for Marion County; and

WHEREAS, in order to remain in compliance with State law regarding the adoption of necessary codes for application in the County, and pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated Sections 5-20-101, *et seq.*, said Board of County Commissioners is authorized to adopt by reference the International Energy Conservation Code (“IECC”), 2018 edition, as published by the ICC, except that Table 402.1.2 Insulation and Fenestration Requirements by Component and Table R402.1.4 Equivalent U-factors are deleted and replaced with Table 402.1.1 Insulation and Fenestration Requirements by Component and Table 402.1.3 Equivalent U-Factors 2009 IECC; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of said Board of County Commissioners to adopt by reference said IECC, 2018 edition, with the exceptions and exclusions set forth herein and above, as the official energy conservation code for the unincorporated areas of Marion County, Tennessee, effective as of June 1, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 22nd day of May, 2023 that the International Energy Conservation Code (“IECC”), 2018 edition, as published by the ICC, except that Table 402.1.2 Insulation and Fenestration Requirements by Component and Table R402.1.4 Equivalent U-factors are deleted and replaced with Table 402.1.1 Insulation and Fenestration Requirements by Component and Table 402.1.3 Equivalent U-Factors 2009 IECC, be and the same is hereby adopted by reference pursuant to T.C.A. Sections 5-20-101, *et seq.*, as a material part of the official building codes for unincorporated Marion County, Tennessee, effective as of June 1, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that three (3) copies of said Code shall be filed and maintained in the office of the County Clerk of Marion County, Tennessee, and kept there for public use, inspection and examination, as required by State law and as provided in prior Code-adopting Resolutions.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Marion County, Tennessee in accordance with the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated Section 5-20-102, and upon such publication, this Resolution shall take

effect on June 1, 2023, and upon the filing of the requisite copies of said International Energy Conservation Code with the County Clerk of Marion County, Tennessee.

SUBJECT: Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund: Commission Amendment #7

Attached you will find our May budget amendment of the General Purpose School Fund (Fund 141) for consideration by the Commission.

The requested budget amendment reflects adjustments for the following:

1. Additional contracted services for speech pathology
2. State grant for Summer Learning Camps
3. Local business grant for technology equipment

In addition, the Board of Education has been awarded a **\$3,700,000** grant from the State for **Innovative School Models**. This is a four-year grant. No funds for this grant will be expended until the 2023-2024 fiscal year. We will not submit a budget for 2022-2023 since no funds will be used.

No increase in the County's local maintenance of effort is being requested.

I respectfully request approval of the proposed budget amendment as reflected herein. This will allow us to meet audit requirements and adjust our accounting records accordingly.
