The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on June 22, 2020. Chairman David Abbott, Mayor David Jackson, Commissioner Franklin, Commissioner Reames, Attorney William Gouger and Deputy Clerk Jamie Rector were present at the Lawson Building. Commissioners participated electronically via the "Go To Meeting" Platform on laptops (via virtual meeting), per Covid-19 guidelines. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Thirteen Commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the May 26, 2020 meeting. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the State of Tennessee Department of Finance and Administration, Benefits Administration, health insurance premium increase of 5.4%. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to leave the TCRS (Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System) at the current rate of 6.86%. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury Engagement Letter of \$10,730.00. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye (which is attached).

Commissioner Kirk joined meeting at this time. 14 Commissioners now present.

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to withdraw from the EMIF (Electronic Monitoring Indigency Fund) Contract agreement and place the \$20,000.00 into the Sheriff's Budget to be used as needed for electronic monitoring devices. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation from the County Mayor to approve a Resolution to adopt the 2020 Amended Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to reject the Bid for renovation of Offices (Marion County Mayor, Register of Deeds, Assessor of Property and County Clerk) from P & C Construction at \$107,331.00 and refer the issue to the Building Use Committee. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve the Resolution authorizing the issuance of County District School Refunding Bonds of Marion County, TN. Making provision for the issuance, sale and payment of said bonds and establishing the terms thereof and the disposition of proceeds therefrom providing for the Levy of Taxes for the payment of principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the bonds. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation from the County Mayor to approve the Marion County Local Government budget amendments. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments, Fund 141 amendment #6 totaling \$238,500.00. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments, Fund 141 amendment #7 totaling \$12,759.00. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Highway Department budget amendments totalling \$537,653.00. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which are attached).

13) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following notaries: Lee Belk, Michael R. Cass, Sheena M. Haller, Patricia O. Hedlund, Patricia B. Powell, Tawnee R. Provencio, Summer A. Rollins, Gail V. Tilson and Randall B. Willis. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.

14) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to adjourn. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
