

The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on April 23, 2018. Chairman Gene Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to approve the minutes from the March 26, 2018 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) Delinquent Property Tax Sale from Tracie L. Jones, Map 130H Group A Parcel 0200.00T001 was tabled to next meeting.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Regional Institute of Higher Education (Chattanooga State Kimball) Change Order No. 4 of \$2,102.76 for Gas Line relocation. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to accept 2nd District School Board Member Theresa Lofty Child's resignation, acknowledge a vacancy in said seat and request an extended qualifying deadline for the August 2018 General Election for that position. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve moving May Meeting from Monday May 28 to Tuesday May 29, 2018 to accommodate the Memorial Day Holiday. 14 voted aye.
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner D. Blansett to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following Notaries: Emily A. Brannigan, Heather L. Clark, Shereen Stewart and Joyce H. Tate. 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the Mayor's recommendation to approve the audit contract with State Comptroller's office for this year's Audit at a cost of \$10,448.00. 14 voted aye.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to Adjourn. 14 voted aye.
