The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on April 22, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the March 25, 2019 meeting. 14 voted aye.

County Mayor, David Jackson, updated the Commission on the Valley View Industrial Sewer Line Contract through the Town of Jasper, which was given a 30 day extension on the project Bid, ending on May 28th, and with private land owner donating \$80,000.00 toward this project. No action was needed from the Commission.

- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Pitney Bowes Lease Agreement on a new machine for the Marion County Election Commission billed quarterly for \$210.96. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Litter Grant Resolution. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve a 5-year subscription Bid for Promethean ActivPanels from Personal Computer Systems, INC. for the Department of Education. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the sale or disposal of Marion County Highway Department Surplus Property. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation from the Tax Sale Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale of Map 055 Parcel 089.01 to Zoe E. Mewis in the amount of \$1,500.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments on IDEA part B reduced by \$1,133.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

8) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).

Commissioner M. Blansett left the meeting. 13 Commissioners now present.



11) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the County Mayor to contact engineer, Jim McGirl of SM&E Engineering to look at road/slide area on backside of Aetna Mountain. 13 voted aye.

12) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner D. Blansett to approve the name of the bridge on Shellmound Road as "Neil Webb Memorial Bridge" and for Commissioner Cookston to coordinate with John Graham and Jim Hawk to set up a date for a Ceremony, contacting Mr. Webb's family. 13 voted aye.

13) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to adjourn. 13 voted aye.
