The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on August 26, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman David Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the July 22, 2019 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Local Government Budget Amendments, a decrease of \$23,804.00 in Fund 101-General and a decrease of \$20,000.00 in Fund 116-Sold Waste/Sanitation. 13 voted aye (which are attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendment for Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund, Commission Amendment #1. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendment for Federal Projects Fund 142, Amendment #1 for IDEA Preschool Discretionary grant, awarded by the State of Tennessee, in the amount of \$10,000.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Board of Education to file form CT-0253 in regards to the lease/purchase of computers for schools' computer labs, to comply with the requirements with the state. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Highway Department budget amendments. 13 voted aye (which are attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following Notaries: Samantha M. Brown, Amber L. Davis, Regina G. Phillips, Kim Hargis, Kimberly G. Layne, Nancy B. Rorex, Terri E. Smith and Sherry A. VanAllman. 13 voted aye.
  
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve the Resolution to participate in the Electronic Monitoring Indigency Fund (EMIF) Local Government Cost Sharing Program, 50/50 split between the County and State approximately \$20,000.00, and a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) committing to pay all liabilities up to the stated budgeted amounts applicable to that fiscal year. 13 voted aye (which are attached).
  
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Contract with the State of Tennessee for Mental Health Evaluations, which are ordered by the Courts, for a discounted rate which will be capped at \$450.00 per day. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
  
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to adjourn. 13 voted aye.
