



The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on August 24, 2020. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fifteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the minutes from the July 27, 2020 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the low BID of \$1,050,006.25 from Thomas Brothers Construction to tar/chip Sequatchie Point Roads in Phase 2, cut new roads and tar/chip in Phase 3. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve a third party inspector, Maureen Handler, with Southern Environmental Technicians for the Sequatchie Point Roads Project not to exceed \$60,000.00. 15 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the recommendation of the County Mayor to accept the only BID from Moss Motor Company for four 2021 Dodge Durangos for the Marion County Sheriff's Department at \$28,363.00 each totaling \$113,452.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the recommendation of the County Mayor to accept the low BID from First Jackson Bank for a Capital Outlay Note of 2.23% for 5 years for the Marion County Highway Department to purchase a Gradall Excavator for \$295,000.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation from the County Mayor to appoint Kevin Merrell to the Marion County Industrial Development Board replacing Don Adkins (due to Adkins not being allowed to be on both County Commission Board and IDB). 15 voted aye.
- 7) County Mayor presented the Report on Debt Obligation for the \$4,315,000.00 County District School refunding Bonds, Series 2020 (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the no cost addendum on the GSA (Government Service Automation) contract for third-party credit card services for the Marion County Circuit Court. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Sheriff's Department to donate a 2006 Dodge Durango to the Marion County Highway Department. 15 voted aye.
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments on Fund 142 Federal Projects Amendment #1 with net change of \$12,393.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments on Fund 142 Federal Projects Amendment #2. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Highway Department budget amendments totaling \$54,562.00. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the following notaries: William B. Beavers, Joyce D. Jordy, Seretha D King, April L. Padgett, Renea Wilson and Catherine Roberts. 15 voted aye.
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to adjourn. 15 voted aye.
