The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on August 29, 2022. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the minutes from the July 25, 2022 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the low bid of \$118,990.00 from Business Systems & Consultants, INC for a Hanel Rotomat Vertical Carousel filing system for Circuit Court Clerk's office. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the County Mayor's recommendation to accept the low bid of \$116,000.00 from Williams Development LLC for the Canopy addition at Marion County Health Department. 13 voted aye (which is attached).

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve the Resolution authorizing the issuance of County District School Bonds of Marion County, TN in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$9,000,000.00 for the purpose of financing school projects; making provision for the issuance, sale and payment of said bonds; establishing the terms thereof and the disposition of proceed therefrom; providing for the levy of taxes for the payment of principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the bonds, due to the additional funding for Jasper Middle School building. 13 voted aye (which is attached).

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to approve the SRO Supervisor position and funding for Jasper Middle School. 13 voted aye.

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to adjourn. 13 voted aye.
