The Marion County Soil Conservation District has received Fiscal Year 2020 funds for the Tennessee Department of Agriculture (TDA) *Agricultural Resources Conservation Fund (ARCF).* Funding is provided to landowners through contracts with the Soil Conservation District (SCD) for the installation of Best Management Practices (BMPs) to push water quality improvements.

Conservation Reserve Program (CRP)

The Farm Service Agency (FSA) has announced open enrollment for it's Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). CRP is a land conservation program administered by FSA. In exchange for a yearly rental payment, farmers enrolled in the program agree to remove environmentally sensitive land from agricultural production and plant species that will improve environmental health and quality.
