The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on February 25, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the minutes from the January 28, 2019 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the "opt in option" for Local Government Retiree Benefit Coverage Election to report Other Postemployment Benefits (OPEB) liabilities on balance sheets if they have retirees in the State Insurance Plan and/or for post retiree employees to carry health insurance through the county at their expense. 12 voted aye, 1 abstained (Hargis) (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the request of Steve Ellis and Charles Ellis, whom are sole owners of property which includes Ellis Park Lane, to abandon and remove Ellis Park Lane from the County Road List. 13 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the 2018-2019 Audit Committee Report. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Inter-local Agreement for Juvenile Detention Services between Bradley County and Marion County at \$120.00 per day per inmate for 3 years. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Resolution to support State Legislation repealing the provision that reduces the Commission retained by the County Register of Deeds Office thereby restoring the retained commission to five percent (5%). 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the upgrade for TAEP Grant program which can be applied for by farmers once they are certified with the State. 13 voted aye (which is attached).

- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the low bid of \$13,049.24 from Turner Security for Panic Alarm System for judges. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation from the Property Tax Sale Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale of Map 155a Group A Parcel 16.00 000 and 16.00 001 to Stephen Vance Moss in the amount of \$6,500.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the recommendation from the Property Tax Sale Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale of Map 049 Parcel 016.06 to Christopher Don Rankin in the amount of \$555.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Local Government Budget Amendment decreasing General Fund balance of \$132,500.00 for Safety Grant, roof on old Health Department building and Health Department Expansion Grant. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments of the Read to Be Ready Summer Grant for 2019 in the amount of \$120,000.00 and the IDEA Preschool grant received an additional \$3,056.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments for Multi-Lease Agreement with Beeler for copier at Marion County High School in the amount of \$303.12 for 60 months and a shredder for Whitwell Middle School in the amount of \$47.85 for 48 months. 12 voted aye, 1 abstained (Blevins) (which is attached).
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the following Notaries: Stephanie M. Colvin, Janice C. Silva, Sharon D. Case, Lisa I. Orange and Tamara R. McAlpin. 13 voted aye.
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to suspend the rules governing purchases and expenditures of funds not on the agenda to allow approval for bid on tree clearing at Marion County Airport. 13 voted aye.
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the low bid of \$75,616.50 from WestCo Land Services, LLC for tree clearing at the Marion County Airport. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 17) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to Adjourn. 13 voted aye.
