The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on January 28, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fifteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the November 26, 2018 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the Chattanooga State Lease Agreement for \$221,250.00 annually payable in installments of \$18,437.50 per month. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve a onetime fee of \$1,770.00 for the Government Service Automation (GSA) Contract for the Marion County Circuit Court Clerk and Sheriff's office to create a Data Exchange Interface in accordance with the Civil Process Interface Specification Document and Criminal Warrants Interface Specification Document and to approve the GSA Contract tabled from the Commission's meeting on November 26, 2018. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Collection Services Agreement Contract with Municipal Service Bureau (MSB). 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Marion County Airport work authorization for tree clearing. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the State of Tennessee Probation and Parole Lease Agreement Extension for \$501.01 per month for space in that building located at 5 North Oak Street, Suite A, Jasper, Tennessee Marion County. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the Automated Material Handling (AMH) Maintenance Contract for \$2100.00 for the Circuit Court Clerk's electronic filing system. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation from the Finance Committee to approve the Resolution to apply for a \$525,000.00 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) with a local match of \$100,000.00, for Water Line Extension on behalf of the City of Dunlap. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve funding for a salary shortage of \$16,363.00 each for the Marion County Sheriff and Marion County Road Superintendent for the fiscal year 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 that is required by the State, which should be at least 10% higher than the salary paid to the general officers of the county, with exception of the County Mayor. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Court Security Grant Program from the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) for \$29,946.82 with a 10 % match from County. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendations from the County Mayor's and Tourism Committee to approve the low bid from Tommy Stokes as Tourism Consultant for \$22,500. 14 voted aye, 1 nay (Tommy Thompson).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the Resolution recognizing the accomplishments of the 2018 Whitwell High School Football Program. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to approve the Tax Sale Parcel Refund for Map 152 Parcel 032.17 for \$794.83 and Map 152 Parcel 032.61 for \$851.56. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the Delinquent Tax Property Map 82 Parcel 10.02 to send a letter to occupant on property to vacate, if unsuccessful, then file a detainer action in General Sessions Court so property can be sold. 15 voted aye.
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the Tax Committees recommendation to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale on property listed as Map 043 Parcel 004.12 to David Kenneth Dancy for \$1,800.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the Tax Committees recommendation to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale on property listed as Map 142 Parcel 102.03 to Chris N. Nguyen and Tutrinh Dong for \$650.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 17) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments totaling \$48,580.00. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 18) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendments totaling \$19,239.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 19) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the 2019 Marion County Highway Department Road List from the Road Superintendent to be kept in the County Clerk's Office. 15 voted aye.

- 20) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the request of the Marion County Road Superintendent asking permission to perform work inside the city limits within the County subject to reimbursement by the cities for such work. 15 voted aye.
- 21) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the Marion County Board of Education Multi-Lease Agreement for Jasper Elementary School copier purposes for \$841.70 per month for 60 months. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 22) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Board of Education Multi-Lease Agreement for Marion County High School copier purposes for \$303.12 per month for 60 months. 14 voted aye, 1 nay (Reeves) (which is attached).
- 23) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the following notaries: Rhonda L. Blizzard, Mary Haley Cash, C. Shawn Henson, Maggie K Lewis, Carolyn W. Stewart, William D. Swafford, Linda P. Townsend, Wanda M. Horton, Whitney D. Sullivan, Amanda D. Gatlin, William L. Gouger Jr., John H. Cameron Jr., Megan A. Duggar, Matilda L. West and June D. Summers. 15 voted aye.
- 24) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Sheriff's request to declare a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria as surplus property in order to donate it to the Hamilton County Sheriff Department Training Division (training would benefit the Marion County Sheriff's Department). 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 25) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Health Department Contract back from July 2018. State to provide \$633,900.00, another \$79,264.00 for extra support and County match of \$11,320.00. 15 voted aye.
- 26) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner D. Blansett to accept recommendation to name the new Shellmound Road Bridge, Neil Webb Bridge in honor of former Road Superintendent Neil Webb. 15 voted aye.
- 27) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to Adjourn. 15 voted aye.
