The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on July 24, 2017. Chairman Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Mayor David Jackson. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the minutes from the June 26, 2017 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Resolution of Marion County Library Board T.C.R.S. (Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System) which would allow the 3 Library Directors, Ms. Stewart of Jasper, Ms. Stewart of South Pittsburg and Ms. Powell of Whitwell, to continue participation in the T.C.R.S. (which is attached). 14 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to accept the Mayor's recommendation to approve Fox Developments as the lowest bid for the Marion County Airport Property Clearing. There were 3 bids, J.D. Thomas Construction LLC (\$36,250.00), Ooltewah Clearing and Grinding (\$28,287.50) and Fox Developments LLC (\$26,800.00). 14 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner White to approve Marion County Highway Department to sell two international dump trucks as Surplus Property. 14 voted aye.
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Abbott and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments (which are attached). 14 voted aye.
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the following notaries: Samantha J. Peak, Paul B. Robinson and Terri R. Thomas. 14 voted aye.
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Multi-Lease Agreement for the Lanier Color Copier at the Whitwell High School Special Education Department (which is attached). 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to adjourn. 14 voted aye.
