The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on June 26, 2017. Chairman Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Gene Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to approve the minutes from the May 22, 2017 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Smith to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Resolution to Adopt a Continuing Budget and Tax Rate for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2017, and to authorize the issuance of Tax Anticipation Notes for the County of Marion (which is attached). 13 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to recess the Marion County Property Tax Set Rate Resolution, Adopt Marion County Budget Approval 2017-2018 Resolution and the Marion County Highway Department Budget Approval 2017-2018 and reconvene on July 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. 13 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the low bid from TNRM (Tennessee Risk Management Trust) as Marion County Workers Compensation carrier for 2017-2018 (which is attached). Roll call vote. 11 voted aye and 2 nay (Don Adkins Jr., Gene Hargis).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to approve the Marion County Airport Property Clearing Bid. Question arose whether bidders should be licensed so Campbell withdrew his motion. Tabled to next meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 6) Commissioners were notified about the Marion County Department of Education Federal Project Fund totaling \$2,219,045.85 (which is attached). 13 voted aye.
- 7) Marion County Highway Department Employee Personnel Policy Amendment/Employee Handbook(s) for March 1, 2017 and July 1, 2017, was given to County Clerk to record and file (which are attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the Delinquent Property Tax Bid Approval for James Nunley on Map 024 Parcel 006.00 for \$2625.00 (which is attached). 13 voted aye.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Smith to accept the County Mayor's Recommendation to approve moving \$3,000,000.00 from the General Fund into the Capital Projects fund (which is attached). 13 voted aye.

10) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments (which are attached). 13 voted aye.

11) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the following notaries: Angela D. Brown, Meegan R. Burton, Mary M. Clark, Garrett D. Cox, Shelby L. Guyear, Susan E. Kean, James M. Rogers Jr., Alicia S. Sitz, Jacki L. Gildard, Nancy R. Rigsby and Linda G. Parker. 13 voted aye.

Meeting Recessed by Chairman Hargis to July 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.

July 10, 2017, Meeting called back in order. Commissioner D. Blansett and Commissioner M. Blansett present. Commissioner Adkins and Commissioner Thompson absent. 13 Commissioners present at this time.

12) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve a Resolution fixing the property tax levy for Marion County at \$2.1686 (which is attached). 12 voted aye, 1 nay (Commissioner Cookston).

13) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner White to approve a Resolution to adopt the Marion County Budget including a Resolution appropriating funds for non-profits for 2017-18 (which is attached). 13 voted aye.

14) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget for 2017-18 (which is attached). 13 voted aye.

15) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to re-bid the Marion County Airport Property Clearing Bid with bids above \$25,000.00 required to be licensed contractors. 13 voted aye.

16) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to adjourn. 13 voted aye.
