The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on June 25, 2018. Chairman Gené Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the minutes from the May 29, 2018 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to decrease the tax rate by ten cents. Roll call vote. 4 voted aye (Blevins, Cookston, Reeves and Thompson) 10 voted nay.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to accept the Finance Committee's recommendation to approve the Resolution for the uniform tax rate for Marion County, Tennessee, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 to be \$2.1686 on each \$100.00 of taxable property county wide. Roll call vote. 13 voted aye, 1 voted nay (Thompson). (Which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to approve the Resolution for the Marion County Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019. 13 voted aye and 1 voted nay (Thompson). (Which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Resolution making appropriations of \$658,307.00 to Nonprofit, Charitable Organizations of Marion County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019 (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept a bid of \$56,470.00 from On-Duty Depot in Knoxville for the purchase and installation of Patrol car equipment for 10 new Dodge Durango AWD's. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to accept the proposal from Southern Health Partner Program for Inmate Medical Services and to enter into an initial one year contract. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Beeler Impressions Multi Lease Agreement for South Pittsburg Elementary School copiers for 60 months at \$434.48 a month. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments of 2018-2019 Original allocations for Federal Projects Fund 142 of \$2,312,439.77. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments of Federal Projects Fund 142 Amendment #5 revised allocations for Title I from \$9,244.00 to \$1,143,566.58 and IDEA Part B from \$3,017.00 to \$1,084,292.84 for 2017-2018. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendment of \$460.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve the following notaries: Dwight Minter, Christy Ellis, Amanda R. Kilgore, Jessica B. Webster, Diane B. Massengale, Cecieta A. Griffith, Chelsea M. Thomasson, Cynthia R. Burton, James C. Eggert and Richard L. Ray. 14 voted aye.
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to discuss at the next Finance Committee Meeting about the possibility of paying off a rural debt service of \$875,000.00. 14 voted aye.
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Abbott and seconded by Commissioner Smith to have a representative from each department, the department of Education and the Highway Department, at the County Commission Meeting if there is an amendment, for any amount, to be passed within that department. 14 voted aye.
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to Adjourn.
