The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on March 26, 2018. Chairman Gene Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.


- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the February 26, 2018 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to accept County Mayor's recommendation to appoint Dwight Bryant to the Marion County Industrial Development Board. 13 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Resolution of the Governing Body of Marion County, Tennessee supporting Legislation establishing Medicaid/TennCare Rates as the Maximum chargeable amount for Medical Services provided to inmates in county jails and state prisons. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Farmers Market application, rules and policies. Application fee will be paid at Extension Office then sent to Trustee's Office to be put into the General Fund and earmarked to be used for improvements at the Farmers Market. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to approve the Delinquent Property tax sale on Map 136 Parcel 002.00 to Clinton Troy Bolton for \$4,900.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments. 13 voted aye (which are attached).

Commissioner Kirk arrived at this time. 14 Commissioners now present.

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve the following Notaries: Margaret Y. Ellis, Veronica D. Jones, Sharon D. Nance and Bedford McBee. 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation by the Marion County Library Board to appoint David Riley to the Board for a 3 year term as Trustee. 14 voted aye.

9) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the County Mayor's, Sheriff Burnett's and Marion County Finance Committee's recommendation to add 7 new School Resource Officers, to place one in all Public Schools, for next year's Budget costing \$ 346,808.00 and asking Marion County School System, including Richard Hardy School, if they could pay half the cost which they cannot commit to at this time. 14 voted aye.

10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to Adjourn. 14 voted aye.
