The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on May 29, 2018. Chairman Gene Hargis called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the April 23, 2018 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve the minutes from the April 30, 2018 specially called emergency meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the Resolution authorizing the County Mayor to sign and submit an application for the Litter and Trash Collecting Grant for fiscal year 2018-2019 from the Tennessee Department of Transportation and authorizing the acceptance of said Grant. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to name the Phase II Marion County Regional Institute of Higher Learning building the "Commissioner's Building." 14 voted aye.
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk approve the Phase II of the Marion County Regional Institute of Higher Education change order request No. 13 (unsuitable soils in parking area, Area 1) for \$9,992.43 and change order request No. 14 (unsuitable soils in parking area, Area 2) for \$9,928.17. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Abbott and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the bid of \$255,220.00 from Moss Motor Company for (ten) 2018 Dodge Durangos for the Marion County Sheriff's Department, which will be paid for in next year's MCSD budget. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve sending RFPs (Request for Proposals) out for Inmate Medical Services. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale bid from Tracie L Jones in the amount of \$1,580.75 for Mobile Home only at Map 130H Group A Parcel 020.00T001. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments for the Read to Be Ready Grant. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following notaries: Katlin Hope Blevins, Jeanetta F. Hambrick, Jerry W. Hutchins, Cindy A. Sharpe, Joseph E. Willard Jr. and Kathryn H. Willard. 14 voted aye.
