The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on October 25, 2021. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fifteen Commissioners were present.


- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the September 27, 2021 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Redistricting Plan Resolution for Marion County. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale BID from Melvin B. Johnson in the amount of \$2,020.00 on property identified as Map 043 Parcel 004.12. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve BID of \$55,800.00 from Municipal Equipment for the purchase of (2) two Stationary Trash Compactors. If BID goes above \$55,800.00 due to "steel market price is subject to change without notice" must go back to Commission for approval. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
  
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the BID of \$35,730.00 from Municipal Equipment for purchase of (2) two 42 Cubic Yard Packer Receiver Containers. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
  
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin if the BID on two 42 Cubic Yard Packer Receiver Containers goes above \$35,730.00 due to "steel market price is subject to change without notice" must go back to Commission for approval. 15 voted.
  
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve a Resolution requesting that funds received from the sale of the Cummings Cove Wildlife Management Area be reinvested in Marion County. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
  
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Adkins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Local Government budget amendments Fund 101 totaling \$6,365.00 and Fund 189-Capital Projects totaling \$164,000.00. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
  
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the following notaries: Susan L. Price, Joshua D. Robinson, Deborah D. Keahey, David Riley, Lola Darlene Davenport and Ashley M. Williams. 15 voted aye.
  
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to ratify the action taken by the County Mayor to approve a 60-day extension (no price increase) for the 2019 CDBG Water Main for completion. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

11) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve \$31,000.00 for Stantec Professional Service Agreement change order which will increase the fees to cover the added 60 days for Task 4 Construction Phase Services and Task 5 Resident Project Representative for the 2019 CDBG Water Main Project. 13 voted aye, 2 nay (Hargis, D. Blansett) (which is attached).

12) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve Croy Engineering (Russell Moorehead) to finish the Rail Spur Extension Design. 15 voted aye.

13) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to adjourn. 15 voted aye.
