The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on April 25, 2022. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the minutes from the March 28, 2022 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Resolution to fill the vacancy of County Clerk, due to the passing of County Clerk Dwight Minter, and appoint Chief Deputy Clerk Joanie Spangler as Interim for the remainder of the existing term of Dwight Minter which will expire on August 31, 2022. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve the one time appropriation of \$3,000.00 to the Marion County Library Board for the Summer Reading Program. 14 voted aye.

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Resolution authorizing the County Mayor to submit an application to the Tennessee Department of Economic & Community Development for a Community Development Block Grant Child Care Grant in an amount up to \$945,000.00 to provide physical improvements to child care providers in Marion County with no County match. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to accept the Marion County Sheriff's request to donate surplus property, 2014 Ford Explorer, to the City of Whitwell. 13 voted aye, 1 abstained (Commissioner Nunley).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System (TCRS) minimum employer rate from 6.86% to 7.20%. 14 voted aye (which is attached).



- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendment Federal Projects Fund 142 Amendment #4 totaling \$46,200.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to approve a 2 year contract with Hudl for \$9,400.00 to the Whitwell High School. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Local Government budget amendments Fund 101 General Fund totaling \$4,590.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to approve the following notaries: Sharon Nance and Lucinda L. Moore. 14 voted aye.
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to elect to use the 10 million dollar standard allowance for the Covid Revenue loss. 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to adjourn. 14 voted aye.
