The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on May 23, 2022. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the minutes from the April 25, 2022 meeting. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the County Mayor's recommendation to accept the bid of \$156,089.00 from Gallagher for Property & Casualty Insurance. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the County Mayor's recommendation to accept the bid of \$83,628.00 from TNRMT (Tennessee Risk Management Trust) for Worker's Compensation. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to re-appoint Bo Burnett, Steve Lamb and Steven Franklin to the 911 Board for a 4 year term. 14 voted aye.

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund Amendment #6 totaling \$269,000.00 (net cash flow adjustment). 14 voted aye (which are attached).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the Finance Committee's recommendation to approve Marion County Local Government budget amendments totaling \$105,000.00 (for 3 patrol cars). 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to approve the Marion County Highway Department budget amendments totaling \$96,496.00. 14 voted aye (which are attached).

- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the following notaries: Taylor Nance, Brandy M. Creekmore, Jimmy Don Cantrell, Sandra Gains-Rings, Jeanetta F. Hambrick, Joyce H. Tate, Jerry W. Hutchins, Samuel Adam Greer, Katlyn B. Layne and Cindy A. Sharpe. 14 voted aye.

- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to suspend the rule which prohibits the County Commission from spending money on items not on the agenda. 14 voted aye.

10) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the purchase of three 2022 Ford Police Interceptors from Ford of Murfreesboro in the amount of \$33,881.00 each (state bid contract). 14 voted aye (which is attached).

11) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to adjourn. 14 voted aye.
