The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on January 25, 2021. Chairman David Abbott, Mayor David Jackson, Commissioner Reames, Attorney William Gouger and Deputy Clerk Jamie Rector were present at the Lawson Building. Commissioners participated electronically via the "Go To Meeting" Platform on laptops (via virtual meeting), per Covid-19 guidelines. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the November 23, 2020 meeting. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to appoint Jimmy Sneed to the Marion County Industrial Development Board of Directors. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept County Mayor's recommendation to appoint Johnny Rogers to the Marion County Planning Commission. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Valmont Industries Pilot Expansion Project, to delegate certain authority to the Industrial and Environmental Development Board of Marion County, Tennessee, and to authorize the County Mayor to enter into and execute an agreement for payments in lieu of Ad Valorem taxes and to take other action in connection with this project. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve the GSA Contract Addendum for the Marion County Circuit Clerk office for addition of integrated Child Support Software. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation of the delinquent Property Tax Committee to approve the sale to Russell Bell in the amount of \$3,501.99 on property identified as Map 133K Group A Parcel 038.00 subject to making Mr. Bell aware there is an outstanding lien on that property and that he would have the right to withdraw his BID. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Local Government Budget Amendments. Totals, Fund 101-General \$555,750.00, Fund 116-Solid Waste \$5,250.00 and Fund189-Capital Projects \$25,000.00. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye (which are attached).

- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments on Fund 141 Commission Amendment #3 for additional BEP funds & Vocational Education MS STEM grant award totaling \$30,000.00 and an addition of \$5,220.01 to Fund 142 Amendment #4 on Carl Perkins Grant. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the following notaries: Mary A. Lewis, Angela N. Morgan, Randi B. Mosier, Jerri L. Rheal, Nicole Sowder, Angela L. West, Veda Turner and Ann. S. Walker. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.


- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to appoint Frances Merriman to the Marion County Library Board. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.

- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Resolution authorizing a continuous Five Year Reappraisal Cycle. 14 voted aye.

12) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner D. Blansett to approve the Change Order for repairs on the roof at the Marion County Airport totaling \$224,000.00. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.

13) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Resolution supporting the Drug Dealer Liability Act Lawsuit. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.

14) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to adjourn. Roll Call Vote. 14 voted aye.
