The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on July 27, 2020. Chairman David Abbott, Mayor David Jackson, Commissioner Franklin, Commissioner Reames, Attorney William Gouger and Deputy Clerk Jamie Rector were present at the Lawson Building. Commissioners participated electronically via the "Go To Meeting" Platform on laptops (via virtual meeting), per Covid-19 guidelines. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen Commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the June 22, 2020 meeting. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to have a Reverse Roll Call Vote for the Set Tax Rate Resolution for 2020-2021. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye, 1 nay (Commissioner Thompson).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Resolution for the Set Tax Rate of \$2.1686 on each \$100.00 of taxable property county wide (no change from previous year) for 2020-2021. Reverse Roll call vote, 13 voted aye, 1 nay (Commissioner Thompson) (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the Resolution for the 2020-2021 Budget. Roll call vote, 12 voted aye, 2 nay (Cookston & Thompson) (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to approve the Resolution making appropriations to nonprofit, charitable organizations of Marion County, TN for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which is attached).
