The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on May 26, 2020. Chairman David Abbott, Mayor David Jackson, Attorney William Gouger and Deputy Clerk Jamie Rector were present at the Lawson Building. Commissioners participated electronically via the "Go To Meeting" Platform on laptops (via virtual meeting), per Covid-19 guidelines. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Twelve Commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the April 27, 2020 meeting. Roll call vote, 12 voted aye.


Commissioner Reames came in and joined the meeting at the Lawson building. 13 Commissioners are now present.

- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Area High Schools Senior Proclamation making the month of July 2020 as Marion County Senior Class Month. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the recommendation of the Emergency Services Committee to approve the County Mayor's Marion County 911 Board of Director appointments (which are attached) to start June 1, 2020 as listed: Bo Burnett – 2 year term, Steve Lamb, EMA Director – 2 year term, Lester Roberts – 3 year term, Jody Rollins – 3 year term, Billy Mason – 4 year term, Wayne Jordan – 4 year term, Kenneth Seagraves – 4 year term, Kay Roberts – 3 year term and Steve Franklin – 2 year term. Roll call vote, 13 voted aye.

- 4) Marion County Computer Audit Report by the State Comptroller found no findings for 2019-2020. (Which is attached).

Commissioner Nunley joined the meeting on computer virtually. 14 Commissioners are now present.

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Marion County Local Government Budget Amendments. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendment #6 Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund to amend the regular education budget for change in Library personnel in the amount of \$500.00. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following Notaries: Sandra Lee Dixon, Kristine Lee Ebrey, Timothy Lee Kendrick and Ashley Ruchelle Sims. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve a 15 mph road sign for Aetna Mountain Road. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to adjourn. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.
