The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on September 28, 2020. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the August 24, 2020 meeting. 14 voted aye.

Chairman Abbott turned the meeting over to Vice-Chairman D. Blansett to accept nominations for Chairman.

- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to nominate and accept Commissioner Abbott for Chairman. 14 voted aye.

At this point, the meeting was turned back over to Chairman Abbott.

- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to nominate and accept Commissioner D. Blansett for Vice-Chairman. 14 voted aye.

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to accept the Building Use Committee's recommendation to sell the Snipes Building to Jenni Davis, DBA Tennessee Behavioral Therapy, LLC for \$40,000.00. 14 voted aye.

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the bid from Axom Enterprise, Inc. for body worn cameras (including mounting hardware, camera hardware, recording software, cloud storage, service, and repair/replace cameras & auxiliary equipment) for the Marion County Sheriff's Department for 5 years totaling \$112,015.90. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the tax sale refund request of \$913.88 to the Burkhardts on parcel previously identified as Map 22 Parcel 005.00 due to a clerical oversight at the Assessor's Office. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the CaresAct funding reimbursement of \$30,251.00 for tourism marketing (the county must spend it to get reimbursed). 14 voted aye.

- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Highway Department's request on declaration of Surplus Property: 2004 Gradall Excavator, 2005 International Tandem Axle Dump truck, 2012 New Holland Tractor & Tiger mower, 1998 GMC Sierra 4x4, 5,000 gallon lot tank, Bush hog attachment, 220K BTU Silent Drive Heater and Snow Plow attachment. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the Property Tax Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale to Kevin R. Anderson in the amount of \$3,080.64 on property identified as Map 073 Parcel 110.00. 14 voted aye (which is attached).

- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the recommendation of the Property Tax Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale to Kevin R. Anderson in the amount of \$1,894.58 on property identified as Map 073 Parcel 110.01. 14 voted aye (which is attached).



13) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the following notaries: Tonya Atterton, Paula G. Cash, Kevin A. Merrell, Susan B. Murakami, Leslie H. Price, Sherry D. Spangler and Jacqueline K. Thompson. 14 voted aye.

14) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the appointment of Sandra Crabtree to the Marion County Library Board due to the resignation of David Riley. 14 voted aye.

15) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to adjourn. 14 voted aye.
