The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on April 27, 2020. Chairman David Abbott, Mayor David Jackson, Attorney William Gouger and Deputy Clerk Jamie Rector are present at the Lavson Building. Commissioners participated electronically via the "Go To Meeting" Platform on laptops (via virtual meeting), per Covid-19 guidelines. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Jamie Rector, Deputy Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the minutes from the February 24, 2020 meeting. Roll call vote, 14 voted aye.

- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Marion County Local Government Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the recommendation of the County Mayor to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendments. 14 voted aye (which are attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the following Notaries: John Harvey Cameron, Kim L. Loewenstein, Erica P. Mashburn, Amy Richards Ridge, Rebecca A. Sanders, Lindsay Elizabeth Taylor, Jennette Arlene Thomas and Catherine Roberts. 14 voted aye.

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the recommendation from the County Mayor to move the May Meeting from Monday the 25<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup> due to the Memorial Day Holiday. 14 voted aye.
