The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on November 26, 2018. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fifteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the minutes from the October 22, 2018 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve a \$500,000.00 grant Resolution adopting and approving the Tennessee Housing Development Agency Policies and Procedures for the 2018 Home Housing Rehabilitation Project. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to approve a Resolution authorizing the County Mayor to request funding totaling \$500,000.00 from the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) to support further development of the Marion County Regional Institute for Technical Excellence Allied Health Training. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Rail Spur improvements Resolution applying for up to \$2,000,000.00 in grant funding from the TDOT to complete proposed rail spur at the Nickajack Port Industrial Park. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the recommendation by the Marion County Library Board of Trustees to add a ninth member, Sherry Nelson for a three year term as a Trustee of the Marion County Library Board. 15 voted aye.
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the recommendation of the Tax Committee to dedicate the property on Orme Mtn. Rd. (Map 135 Parcel 014.05) to the City of South Pittsburg at no cost for use as a water tank site, waving the \$2,844.49 back taxes. 14 voted aye, 1 abstained, D. Blansett (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve the Speedway Annexation Revenue Interlocal Agreement on the division of all annexation date revenue generated from the Speedway property after the statutory allocation to the county school system 50/50 between the Town of Jasper and Marion County. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by commissioner Blevins to table the Circuit Court Clerk Software Contract to the next County Commission Meeting.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to accept the Tax Committees recommendation to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale on property listed as Map 139 Parcel 011.00 for \$5,053.63. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the Tax Committees recommendation to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale on property listed as Map 138 Parcel 003.07 for \$4,518.42. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the Tax Committees recommendation to approve the Delinquent Property Tax Sale on property listed as Map 139 Parcel 011.01 for \$4,318.31. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 20) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve cancellation of the scheduled meeting in December due to Christmas Holiday and next meeting will be on January 28, 2019. 15 voted aye.

- 21) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the following notaries: Amanda N. Hutchins, Johnny L. Morrison and Karen E. Radke. 15 voted aye.
- 22) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to suspend the Commission's rule to allow consideration of the Body Worn Camera Bid, which was not placed on the agenda. 15 voted aye.
- 23) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the Body Worn Camera Bid for \$20,160.00. 14 voted aye, 1 abstained (Hargis) (which is attached).
- 24) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to Adjourn. 15 voted aye.
