

The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on November 25, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Thompson. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the minutes from the October 28, 2019 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the low bid of \$50,544.00 from Green Guard First Aide and Safety for 54 AED Defibrillators to be placed in all patrol cars and County buildings. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to accept the bid of \$25,580.00 from Moss Motors for a new 2020 Durango to replace the Marion County Sheriff's Department Patrol Car that was hit and insurance totaled out for \$28,000.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the bid of \$165,932.77 from Tennessee Kenworth for a 2021 Kenworth Model T880 and Galbreath Roll-Off Cable Hoist. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the bid of \$14,548.00 by Recreational Concepts for the Marion County Park exercise equipment using the State Health Department Grant of \$20,000.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).

- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Adkins to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Mueller Co. Payment-In-Lieu-of-Tax (Pilot) Program. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Thompson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the appointment of Robert Kelly to the Marion County Planning Commission Member. 13 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to not have a County Commission meeting in December. 13 voted aye.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the renewal for a 5 year Edupoint contract with Marion County Board of Education for the TDOE Student Management System. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to approve a 2 year license with Pro for Schools online Professional Development for \$4,200.00 using the Arts Grant which was approved by the County Commission in July. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendment for Fund 142 Amendment #4 for the IDEA Discretionary Grant of \$12,500.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendment for Fund 141 Amendment #4 for the State subsidy for SIS (Student Information Systems). 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to Table the delinquent property tax sale on property identified as Map 073 Parcel 057.06. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale to Michael Conkle in the amount of \$2,671.00 on property identified as Map 152 Parcel 007.45. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale to Michael Conkle in the amount of \$1,859.00 on property identified as Map 152 Parcel 007.46. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale to Tony and Gaye Vestal in the amount of \$4,700.00 on property identified as Map 133K Group A Parcel 048.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 17) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Local Government budget amendments. 13 voted aye (which are attached).
- 18) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Cookston to approve the following notary: Cindy Young. 13 voted aye.

- 19) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the recommendation of the Building Use Committee to approve renting the Velma Snipes Building to Billy and Linda Mason for \$600.00 per month. 13 voted aye.
- 20) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to have the County Mayor send a letter to the Marion County School Board requesting a report regarding an update on the middle school building project and other projects by the next meeting on January 27, 2020. 13 voted aye.
- 21) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to adjourn. 13 voted aye.
