



The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on October 22, 2018. Vice Chairman Donald Blansett called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Blevins. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Thirteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the September 24, 2018 meeting. 13 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Resolution to name a portion of US Hwy 41 in Marion County "Captain Christian Calvin Doak, US Army Retired, Memorial Highway". 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve a Resolution adopting a Limited English Proficiency Policy for Marion County, TN. 12 voted aye, 1 voted nay, Thompson (which is attached).
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to divide all annexation date revenue generated from the speedway property after the statutory allocation to the county school system 50/50 between the Town of Jasper and Marion County, for 15 years as provided by law. 13 voted aye (which are attached).
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to accept the withdrawal of Geoffrey and Nancy Post's petition to close Crossroads R (also referred to as Cross Creek Road and Wynne Wash Road). 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Highway Department request to surplus and auction the following: 1996 International Dump truck, 1993 Tiger tractor, 1992 Gradall, 1985 Athey loader, 1992 Ford single axle truck, 5 tool boxes, Lincoln gas powered welder and 70 loads of topsoil. 13 voted aye (which is attached).

- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the sale of Delinquent Tax Property on Map 068 Parcel 011.01 to Lawrence Ronnie Jordan and Karen Ann Jordan in the amount of \$900.00. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) Properties identified as Map 139 Parcel 011.00, Map 138 Parcel 003.07 and Map 139 Parcel 011.01, as recommended by the Delinquent Property Tax Committee, were not timely published in the newspaper so they were tabled, and property shown as Map 135 Parcel 014.05 was pulled out of the sale by the County Mayor because South Pittsburg Water Company may place a water tank on it. If they don't, the property will be put back up for sale.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by commissioner D. Blansett to approve the Marion County Budget Amendments to increase revenue in General fund of \$6,000.00 for State Grants and expenditure towards the expansion of the Marion County Health Department. 13 voted aye (which is attached).
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Highway Department Budget Amendments of Revenues/Expenditures in the amount of \$88,585.00. 13 voted aye (which are attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following Notaries: James W. Bible, Jerry B. Bible, Sarah B. Willis, Vicki K Messer, Connie D. Schaerer and Terrie L. Scharer. 13 voted aye.
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to Adjourn. 13 voted aye.
