



The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on October 28, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Chairman Abbott. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fifteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the minutes from the September 23, 2019 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner D. Blansett to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Croy Engineering, LLC contract for \$62,400.00 at 4.1% on Sequatchie Pointe Subdivision Road. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Stantec Professional Services Agreement for \$95,000.00 on the Alvin York Highway Water Line Design. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to draw up a Resolution to be sent to Tennessee legislators, Commissioner of Safety and Governor requesting support to keep our Tow Truck Operators indexed so they will be selected in a deliberant manner during accident calls. 15 voted aye.
- 17) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to adjourn. 15 voted aye.
