The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on September 25, 2017. Vice Chairman D. Blansett called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Mayor David Jackson. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fourteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve the minutes from the August 28, 2017 meeting. 14 voted aye.

Vice Chairman D. Blansett turned meeting over to Commissioner Campbell for Election of Chairman and Vice Chairman.

- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to nominate Gene Hargis for Chairman. 14 voted aye.

- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to nominate D. Blansett for Vice Chairman. 14 voted aye.

Commissioner Campbell turned meeting over to Vice Chairman D. Blansett.

- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve John Newton, Janet Rollins and Jan Gilliam for the vacant positions on the Agriculture Extension Committee Board. 14 voted aye.

Discussion on putting Litigation Tax on Criminal Cases. After research, County Attorney Billy Gouger said the County was already receiving that tax on criminal cases.

- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner Abbott and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to host and partially fund, in the amount of \$2,000.00, to the Bass Federation Tournament in May 2018. Roll call vote. 11 voted aye, 3 nay (Commissioner M. Blansett, Commissioner Blevins and Commissioner Thompson).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to move the consideration of Proposal of the Lofty Construction from the table for discussion. 14 voted aye.
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner M. Blansett and Seconded by Commissioner Grayson to reject the Lofty Construction Proposal. 14 voted aye.
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Grayson and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Sewer Service Line Easement for Genter and Sherrill Properties (which is attached). 14 voted aye.
- 9) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the Delinquent Property Sale Bid of \$1,243.88 from Barry W. Cookston on property identified as Map 033 Parcel 011.05 (which is attached). 14 voted aye.

- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Abbott and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the Marion County Budget Amendments (which are attached). 14 voted aye.
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Board of Education Budget Amendments for the Federal Projects Fund 142 Amendment #3. Title I receiving additional allocation of \$5,080.00 and the Read to be Ready Summer Grant receiving additional allocation of \$461.02 (which are attached). 14 voted aye.
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to approve the Marion County Board of Education Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund, Budget Amendment #3 (which is attached). 14 voted aye.
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the following notaries: Heather Debter, Virginia E. Debter, Regena E. Howell, Marttie J. Richards, Carol S. Condra, Dottie B. Sneed, Lyndia S. Sargent, Susan L. Price and Dawn E. Smartt. 14 voted aye.
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to waive the interest and penalty fees (which were due to Assessor's error) of \$386.25 on Mr. Eggert property Map 050H C 010.00 (which is attached). 14 voted aye.
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to accept the County Mayor's recommendation to appoint Jerry D. Moss to Stone River Regional Library Board and Rena Looney to a 3 year term for Trustee on the Marion County Library Board. 14 voted aye.
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to adjourn. 14 voted aye.
