



The Marion County Board of Commissioners met in a regular called session on September 23, 2019. Chairman David Abbott called the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Commissioner Hargis. Roll call was taken by Dwight Minter, County Clerk. Fifteen commissioners were present.

- 1) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the minutes from the August 26, 2019 meeting. 15 voted aye.
- 2) A motion was made by Commissioner Franklin and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the nomination of Commissioner D. Blansett as temporary Chairman. 15 voted aye.
- 3) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to nominate Commissioner Abbott for Chairman. 15 voted aye. Commissioner Thompson made a motion to cease nominations and was seconded by Commissioner Adkins resulting in Commissioner Abbott being elected as Chairman. 15 voted aye.
- 4) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Franklin to elect Commissioner D. Blansett as Vice-Chairman. 15 voted aye.
- 5) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the County Mayor to sign the Work Authorization for the Marion County Airport Sanitary Sewer Line. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 6) A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the County Mayor to sign the Work Authorization for the Marion County Airport Hangar Rehab. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 7) A motion was made by Commissioner Reames and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Resolution to apply for funding through the Select Tennessee Site Development Grant. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 8) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Skiles to approve the Resolution adopting the International Building Codes, 2018 Edition which will go into effect January 01, 2020. 15 voted aye (which is attached).

- 9) Resolution for Park Ridge West Hospital was tabled to next meeting.
- 10) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to accept the recommendation from the Property Tax Sale Committee to approve the delinquent property tax sale identified as Map 051P Group A Parcel 057.00 to James M. Steele for \$20,000.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 11) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Highway Department to work for the Emergency 911 district on an access road and tower site on RA Griffith highway. 15 voted aye.
- 12) A motion was made by Commissioner D. Blansett and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the recommendation of the Finance Committee to accept the Sequatchie Pointe Lawsuit Settlement of \$1.5 million plus court clerk fees and last mediation fees. 15 voted aye.
- 13) A motion was made by Commissioner Hargis and seconded by Commissioner Reames to approve the Marion County Board of Education to renew the Maintenance Contract for AED's (heart monitors) for 3 additional years for \$5,490.00 per year. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 14) A motion was made by Commissioner Reeves and seconded by Commissioner Blevins to approve the Marion County Local Government budget amendments. 15 voted aye (which are attached).
- 15) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner M. Blansett to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments for Federal Projects Fund 142, amendment #2, the State of TN awarded the Marion County Schools a Perkins Reserve grant in the amount of \$46,350.00. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 16) A motion was made by Commissioner Blevins and seconded by Commissioner Grayson to approve the Marion County Board of Education budget amendments for Fund 141 General Purpose School Fund: Commission Amendment #2. 15 voted aye (which is attached).
- 17) A motion was made by Commissioner Cookston and seconded by Commissioner Reeves to approve the following notaries: Ronnie JT Blevins II, Whitney Autumn Martin, Taylor Mariah Stoddard and Joanie Spangler. 15 voted aye.
- 18) A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Hargis to accept the nomination of Sherry Nelson to the Stones River Regional Library Board of Trustees. 15 voted aye.
- 19) A motion was made by Commissioner Skiles and seconded by Commissioner Reames to accept the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury letter acknowledging the receipt of a certified copy of the fiscal year 2020 Budget and approving the budget. 15 voted aye.
- 20) A motion was made by Commissioner and seconded by Commissioner to adjourn. 15 voted aye.
